Re: End of 2025 Water Season

Dear Water User,

On August 20, 2025, the Board of Directors of the Patterson Irrigation District (PID or District) voted to end the 2025 irrigation season on November 14, 2025.

November 14 was set to complete final items on the Pumping Plant 4 Project. We need to shut the Main Canal down to perform some vital change overs from temporary equipment to permanent, and to construct additional pieces of the pump station pond that requires the Main Canal to be down for roughly a month into late December.

Prior to November 14, and as the District rolls into the fall and winter months with irrigation demand dropping, District operations will also go into maintenance mode. During this period, the District will be making water available on a limited basis and "bunch up" the orders to accommodate the winter maintenance activities of the District. Water will be made available during these bunched periods only Monday-Friday. This period will start sometime in October, depending on demand.

Please take note that District deliveries during the week leading up to November 14<sup>th</sup> will be reduced with the intention to shut orders off that afternoon.

Once the Main Canal is back in operation in late December/early January, laterals throughout the District will be periodically shut down for maintenance activities and water will not be available. Again, please plan your irrigations with the District in advance in the event we are maintaining a lateral and cannot get you water. In addition, the water will be available on a limited basis with Monday-Friday deliveries until demand reaches a point that we need to move to nonstop deliveries.

Please plan accordingly and request water as far in advance as possible so District staff can make accommodations. In the event of a dry winter and operational changes are required, adjustments to the schedule may occur. Thank you.
